The Community & Social Development Section (CSDS), Artane - Whitehall LEA continue to meet and support a wide range of community & residents groups in the area on an ongoing basis.

Bealtaine Arts Exhibition

As part of this years' Bealtaine Festival, CSDS in conjunction with Coolock Library Art group organised an arts exhibition in Northside Shopping Centre. The exhibition was open to the public each weekday morning from 1st May to 10th May. The exhibition displayed works from Coolock Library, Golden Years, St Luke's, Lorcan, Bonnybrook, Santry, Priorswood Men's Arts Group and North Dublin Artist Club. Older People's Council

The Older People's Council (OPC), North Central Area met in April and have agreed the objectives for their yearly workplan. Both North Central's CSDS will work with the OPC on their recommended actions.

They are actively seeking new members to join the club. Dublin City Council Community Officer will support the members while they are settling into their new home.





Another Way 5K

The annual "Another Way 5k", Darndale was supported by CSDS. The race was held on 27th April in Darndale Park. Great fun was had by all who attended, ran and helped out on the day. This fantastic event is growing year on year, with over 500 runners completing the race. This event is supported by a number of sections within Dublin City Council.



Summer Projects

CSDS with the support of Crosscare met with the newly established Summer Project for the Larkhill area, D9 Next Generation. The group will run a small project during the summer. This summer project will be allocated funding through the Summer Project budget that is managed through Crosscare each year. The group have registered with Crosscare and will receive on going support and training.

The CSDS will continue to allocate funding to the non-voluntary summer projects within the LEA. All non voluntary groups that run a summer project have received the funding application form. This funding supports the summer activities that each organisations run for the young people in their area.

Memory Café, Whitehall
