

6 new signs were erected in the Community Gardens in Ardmore Montrose Park














Special Clean-ups

The amenity area in **Beechpark Court - Coolock** was powerwashed to remove the moss.






The access ramps into **Ardmore Montrose Park – Artane** were powerhosed to remove the moss to make them safe for park users
