This Area Committee calls on the Area Manager to write to VEC requesting them to address a problem at the entrance gate to the sports complex at St Kevin College, Clogher Road, Crumlin. The gate is too low allowing anti-social elements to climb over causing disturbance to residents and possible damage to property. An extension onto the gate would resolve this problem for all interested parties.

That the South Central Area Committee ask the Area Manager to write to the VEC to ascertain if the entrance gates to the VEC Sports Grounds and Crèche, Clogher Road, which are directly next to my constituent, could be raised to deter youths constantly jumping over this gate in the evenings and weekends when the gate is closed up. There had been an old high gate previously in place to the entrance of this site, and when the new build was completed, a new much lower gate was put in place.
