May Motions: -

378 Councillor Pat Dunne

This Area Committee notes with concern that the number of housing voids in Dublin South Central has increased once again and that this against the background of the current housing crisis is unacceptable.

379 Councillor Paul Hand

That this Area Committee is concerned at the lack of public transport options for many residents in Chapelizod to visit nearby Ballyfermot. Unfortunately the 76 only serves a small portion of the South-West of Chapelizod. Therefore, the South Central Area Committee would request that Dublin Bus consider re-routing the 26 bus through Chapelizod, along the Lucan Road, then along the Kylemore Road and to then travel down the Ballyfermot Road to Palmerstown as this would cater for the many residents, elderly and otherwise in Northern and Eastern Chapelizod to be able to visit the nearest commercial centre and conduct their business. Therefore we request the Area Manager to forward this to Dublin Bus for their consideration.

380 Councillor Tina MacVeigh

That this Area Committee fully supports the Bridgefoot Street Park Campaign for a park on the site and notes with great disappointment the decision taken to cancel the design consultation workshops. Furthermore, this Area Committee calls on the Area Manager to reschedule the workshops as a matter of urgency and directs the Housing Manager to support this.

381 Councillor Greg Kelly

This Area Committee calls on the New Minister for Environment to release funds to Dublin City Council and Housing Bodies so planned Social Housing projects can get started as a matter of urgency.

382 Councillor Pat Dunne

This Area Committee notes with concern that the plans for a public park on Bridgefoot Street have been delayed because our Housing and Residential Services requested that the public consultation be deferred until such time as their housing requirements for this site are determined. This decision is contrary to the Liberties Greening strategy and is a huge disappointment to local residents.

383 Councillor Greg Kelly

This Area Committee calls on the Housing Department of Dublin City Council to put in place plans to increase the housing stock to meet the demands of the Dublin City Council waiting list and homeless List. This should include getting a commitment from the Minister to fund a Dublin City Council Building Programme on Dublin City Council lands and a timeframe for this to be implemented.
