

## MINUTES OF THE DUBLIN CITY JPC MEETING

## HELD ON TUESDAY 9 MAY 2017

### 1 Minutes of meeting held on 14th March 2017

Agreed.

Councillor Daithí De Róiste, Chairperson, welcomed Assistant Commissioner John O'Driscoll to the meeting. He has temporarily assumed the duties of outgoing Assistant Commissioner Jack Nolan (retired). However it is expected that a permanent Assistant Commissioner for the area will be appointed in the coming week.

### 2 Begging Study - Ms. Alice O'Flynn, Researcher

Alice O'Flynn, author of report, discussed the report in detail addressing any queries that arose.

#### 3 Community CCTV

Noted.

On 13<sup>th</sup> April 2017 the Tánaiste & Minister for Justice and Equality, Frances Fitzgerald T.D. announced a new grant aid scheme for community-based CCTV systems. Under the scheme, eligible community groups may apply for grant-aid of up to 60% of the total capital cost of a proposed CCTV system, up to a maximum grant of €40,000. A total of €1million is available nationally; scheme will run for 3 years with funding of €1 million available each year.
