This Area Committee calls on the Event Management Office of Dublin City Council to form a Working Group of stakeholders to include representatives of local residents associations, representatives of IMMA, Garda, representatives, local businesses and public representatives either as prescribed body under the Regulations or as a non prescribed advisory body, to ensure greater consultation and input from the local community, in respect of concerts and outdoor events at the Royal Hospital, Kilmainham.

This Area Committee notes with concern that Crumlin Swimming Pool has had to close from the 3rd July, to allow for investigations into a suspected water leak. We request that minimum disruption be caused to pool users over the coming period. Furthermore and most importantly, we call on our Sports Development Section to undertake to make maximum public usage of this facility a priority policy going forward. The people of Crumlin and surrounding areas should be able to use the pool for public swimming throughout the year.
