I regret the project was shelved and I believe is still on the NTA agenda. I am asking for the NTA to be invited into a future meeting to update the elected members on where this project is at and how we can campaign and ensure this happens. If I remember it was the Yellow Line.

That Dublin City Council seeks to provide a Community Centre infrastructure enhancement fund for the Dublin City Council Area to allow the enhancement / upgrade of current facilities which are in need of improvements.
