TERENURE DISTRICT

- There has been 4 detections for the Sale/Supply of Drugs to date this year (5 for the same period in 2016).
- There have been 10 arrests for Driving whilst intoxicated in 2017 as opposed to 9 for the same period last year, an increase of 11%.
- There has been 0 Fatal Road Traffic Accidents recorded in 2017 (0 in 2016).
- 21 Public Order incidents are recorded in 2017 as opposed to 7 in 2016, an increase of 200%.
- 4 Incidents of Assault Causing Harm are recorded in 2017 (7 in 2016).
- 17 incidents of Minor Assault are recorded in 2017 (20 in 2016, a decrease of 15%).

SUNDRIVE SUB-DISTRICT

- There have been 2 detections for the Sale/Supply of Drugs to date this year (2 in 2016).
- There has been 6 arrests for Driving whilst intoxicated in 2017 (1 in 2016)
- There are no Fatal Road Traffic Accidents recorded in 2017 (0 in 2016).
- 19 Public Order incidents are recorded in 2017 as opposed to 8 in 2016, an increase of 138%.
- 4 Incidents of Assault Causing Harm are recorded in 2017 (3 in 2016).
- 10 incidents of Minor Assault are recorded in 2017 (7 in 2016, an increase of 43%).
