**Item 3**

That this Committee requests the Traffic Management Department, as a matter of urgency, to examine the traffic situation at Grangegorman Lower at the entrance to the school at Fitzwilliam Place North (Off Grangegorman Lower) with a view to immediately banning construction traffic from Grangegorman Lower during school drop off and pick up times. In addition, major traffic calming measure for the road should be examined and considered.
