Assistant Chief Executive's report to Dublin City Joint Policing Committee

Webcasting of meetings

At a meeting of the Dublin City Joint Policing Committee held on January 12th 2016, Webcasting of Meetings was listed as an agenda item. A majority decision was taken not to webcast meetings at that point in time, with a commitment given to revisit the issue at a later date. Members were again consulted on their views at the May 2017 meeting, at which it was decided to postpone a decision to today's meeting.

Annual Report of the Joint Policing Committees

A draft copy of this report has been circulated to members. It is anticipated that this will be brought to the September City Council for formal approval, subject to the agreement of members.

Policing Authority

The Policing Authority's Annual Report 2016 was published on 27th April 2017 and is available on their website.

The Authority held a meeting of the Chairpersons of the Joint Policing Committees and Chief Executives of Local Authorities on Wednesday 5th July last, the objective being to assist in determining the 2018 Policing Priorities.

The Policing Authority will continue to hold approximately 11 meetings annually and a minimum of 4 of these will be open to members of the public to attend. The upcoming meeting dates for 2017 are as follows:
