Proposal to declare the pedestrian access route at The Crescent, Collinswood, Beaumont Road, Dublin 9 to be public roads & footpaths

The legal procedure to declare the pedestrian access route as detailed above to be public roads & footpaths was initiated under Section 11 of the Roads Act 1993, as set out in Subsections 4 and 5 of Section 180 Planning and Development Act 2000, as amended by Planning and Development (Amendment) Act 2010

The proposal is shown on attached copy Drawing No R.M. 36769A

Note: The grass verges highlighted on the drawing are included in the Taking in Charge.

At its meeting on 19th June 2017 the North Central Area Committee recommended that the necessary statutory procedure be initiated with a view to **“taking in charge”** the aforementioned pedestrian access route..

By public advertisement on the 29th June 2017 representations or objections were invited before 22nd August 2017.

The declaration of a road to be a public road under the provisions of Section 11 of the Roads Act 1993, as set out in Subsections 4 and 5 of Section 180 Planning and Development Act 2000, as amended by Planning and Development (Amendment) Act 2010 is a reserved function.
