- Commencement and cessation date for the trial;
- Details of who will assess the road closure;
- Criteria used to assess the road closure;
- An assessment of the impact on the local community and how this will be carried out;
- An assessment of the impact on the wider community (Home Farm Rd, Mobhi Rd, Drumcondra Rd, Grace Park Road etc) and how this will be carried out;
- An assessment of the impact on the local schools, including feedback from staff and parents;
- To provide contact details to all residents in the locality to provide their comments and views;
- To confirm whether a vote by residents will take place and who will be eligible to vote;
- To give consideration to the use of movable barriers that can be raised and lowered according to peak traffic;
- To confirm that any structures put in now are movable if the trial is deemed unsuccessful.

Reason for Emergency Motion:

Walsh Road procurement is now complete and works are expected to be completed before schools resume in September. This is the final opportunity for NWAC to discuss this issue before the works are complete.
