- There were no murders in 2017.
- There have been 115 detections for the Sale/Supply of Drugs in 2017 as opposed to 117 for the same period last year, representing an decrease of 2%.
- There have been 39 arrests for Driving whilst intoxicated in 2017 in comparison to 48 for the same period last year an decrease of 19%.
- There are 3 Fatal Road Traffic Accidents recorded in 2017 as opposed to 0 representing an increase of 300%.
- 308 Public Order Incidents are recorded in 2017 as opposed to 280 in 2016, showing a increase of 10%.
- 50 Incidents of Drunkenness are recorded in 2017 as opposed to 32 in 2016, an increase of 56%.
- 78 Incidents of Assault causing Harm are recorded in 2017, as opposed to 77 in 2016, an increase of 1% .
- 224 Incidents of Minor Assault are recorded in 2017 as opposed to 201 in the same period last year showing a increase of 11%.

It should be noted that in any reference to statistics, those statistics are provisional, operational, liable to change and some possibly re-classified with the introduction of Central Statistics Office reports.
