CRUMLIN DISTRICT

- There has been 25 detections for the Sale/Supply of Drugs in 2017 (35 for in 2016, a decrease of 29%).
- There have been 33 arrests for Driving whilst intoxicated in 2017 as opposed to 29 for 2016, an increase of 14%.
- There is no Fatal Road Traffic Accident recorded in 2017 (0 in 2016).
- 78 Public Order incidents are recorded in 2017 as opposed to 91 in 2016, a decrease of 14%.
- 35 Incidents of Assault Causing Harm are recorded in 2017 (30 in 2016).
- 72 incidents of Minor Assault are recorded in 2017 (62 in 2016, an increase of 16%).

TERENURE SUB-DISTRICT

- There have been 12 detections for the Sale/Supply of Drugs to date in 2017 (10 in 2016).
- There has been 18 arrests for Driving whilst intoxicated in 2017 as opposed to 21 for 2016, a decrease of 14%.
- There are 2 Fatal Road Traffic Accidents recorded in 2017 (0 in 2016).
- 18 Public Order incidents are recorded in 2017 as opposed to 23 in 2016, a decrease of 22%.
- 9 Incidents of Assault Causing Harm are recorded in 2017 (3 in 2016).
- 22 incidents of Minor Assault are recorded in 2017 (27 in 2016, a decrease of 19%).
