

Monthly Local Fund Statement

Background

Attached for consideration by the elected members in this October Council Agenda is the Local Fund Statement for the period 29th July 2017 to 25th August 2017. This report is presented in a format agreed at the Finance SPC and noted by the City Council at its meeting in September 2011. The agreed format provides information on:

- Monthly receipts and payments for current period and same period last year.
- Cumulative receipts and payments for current year and last year.
- Details of main receipting areas and receipts over €1m for the current month and same period last year.
- Details of payroll payments and non pay payments over €1m in the current month and same period last year.

Overview

Over the period 29/07/17 to 25/08/17 Dublin City Council made payments to the value of €144.9m. Dublin City Council receipted €132.8m of funds with a period deficit of payments over receipts of €12m moving to a net debit balance at period end of €15.8m. This value of €15.8m is the maximum value applicable, as it includes the full value of payments made whether cashed or not. As at 25/08/2017 Dublin City Council had placed €102m on investment. The value of transactions to investments over the period was €47m. The value of transactions from investments over the period was €70m. There were 4 weeks in each of the August periods for 2016 and 2017.

Receipts

During the period Dublin City Council receipted €132.8m. €9m was received from the Department of Housing, Planning, & Local Government, of which €1.8m refers to homeless emergency accommodation and €4.2m was received in respect of RAS Rents for Quarter 3 2017. €4.3m was received from other local authorities in respect of Fire Services; €1.2 from Dun Laoghaire Rathdown County Council (for August 2017), €1.6m from Fingal County Council and €1.5m from South Dublin County Council (both for July 2017). A payment of €500k was also received from Dun Laoghaire Rathdown County Council in relation to a contribution for Homeless Policy Quarter 3. Commercial Rates received in the 2017 period amount to €23.3m. €4m was received from Irish Water in respect of costs incurred through the execution of the Service Level Agreement in July 2017. €2m was received in respect of Development Levies. Parking meter receipts in the period amount to €2.3m, €1.3m from

collections and €912k from tags and mobile receipts. The collection value relates to 22 days in 2017 as against 12 days in 2016. Housing loans value is reduced in 2017 as the direct debit for the period was processed in September 2017.

Payments

During the period Dublin City Council made payments to the value of €144.9m. €16.3m was paid to the Housing Finance Agency in respect of loan redemptions and payments. €6.7m was paid to the Revenue Commissioners in respect of PAYE/PRSI for August 2017. €4m was paid to contractors, of which, €1.5m was paid to NABCO in respect of CALF payments regarding Richmond Road and Orchard Lawns, €1.1m was paid to Adston Ltd for provision of rapid delivery housing units at Cherry Orchard and €1.5m was paid to Purcell Construction for construction and refurbishment of apartments at Dolphins Barn.

EU/IMF Reporting

The next report under the EU/IMF reporting framework is for the 3rd Quarter 2017 (i.e. July - September). The deadline for submission of the EU/IMF reports is 24th November 2017. These reports will be included with the Financial Report for the January 2018 City Council meeting.
