Monthly Local Fund Statement

Background

Attached for consideration by the elected members in this January Council Agenda is the Local Fund Statement for the period 31st October 2015 to 27th November 2015. This report is presented in a format agreed at the Finance SPC and noted by the City Council at its meeting in September 2011. The agreed format provides information on:

- Monthly receipts and payments for current period and same period last year.
- Cumulative receipts and payments for current year and last year.
- Details of main receipting areas and receipts over €1m for the current month and same period last year.
- Details of payroll payments and non pay payments over €1m in the current month and same period last year.

Overview

Over the period 31/10/15 to 27/11/15 Dublin City Council made payments to the value of \in 78.3m. Dublin City Council receipted \in 69.9m of funds with a period deficit of payments over receipts of \in 8.4m moving to a net credit balance at period end of \in 14.1m. This value of \in 14.1m is the maximum value applicable, as it includes the full value of payments made whether cashed or not. As at 27/11/2015 Dublin City Council had placed \in 45.8m on investment.

Receipts

During the period Dublin City Council receipted €69.9m. €2.4m was received from the Department of the Environment, of which, €1.4m was received for 11 Clifden Terrace, and €491k for provision of waste enforcement. €9m was received in respect of the Local Government Fund Allocation. €4.2m was received from other local authorities in respect of fire services, €1.5m from Fingal County Council (for October 2015), €1.5m from South Dublin County Council and €1.2m from Dun Laoghaire Rathdown County Council (both for November 2015). €1.2m was received from Irish Water in respect of costs incurred through the execution of the Service Level Agreement. €1.8m was received in respect of the Waste to Energy Plan for the Community Gain Fund. €1.2m was received from the Housing Finance Agency in respect of Variable Loan Annuities. €5.3m was received in respect of

Housing Rents. €1.6m was received in respect of Housing Loans. Parking meter receipts in the period amount to €2.7m. Rates receipts in the period amount to €16.6m.

Payments

During the period Dublin City Council made payments to the value of €78.3m. €3.5m was paid to Dunbar Assets Ireland in relation to the acquisition of Dalymount Park. €1.1m was paid to Ryans Solicitors on behalf of Hail for 7 units at Rathmines Court. €1m was paid to Crosscare, Catholic Social Services for Quarter 4 interim payments for Homeless services. €2.8m was paid to the Revenue Commissioners for Value Added Tax (€2.4m), Relevant Contracts Tax (€69k), and Professional Services Withholding Tax (€437k).

EU/IMF Reporting

The next report under the EU/IMF reporting framework is for the 4th Quarter 2015 (i.e. October – December 2015). Dublin City Council must submit the suite of reports to the DOE by Wednesday 24th February 2016. The EU/IMF reports will be included with the March 2016 City Council Financial Report.
