- There were no murders in 2017.
- There have been 145 detections for the Sale/Supply of Drugs in 2017 as opposed to 139 for the same period last year, representing an increase of 4%.
- There have been 48 arrests for Driving whilst intoxicated in 2017 in comparison to 58 for the same period last year an decrease of 17%.
- There are 3 Fatal Road Traffic Accidents recorded in 2017 as opposed to 1 representing an increase of 200%.
- 388 Public Order Incidents are recorded in 2017 as opposed to 358 in 2016, showing a increase of 8%.
- 65 Incidents of Drunkenness are recorded in 2017 as opposed to 42 in 2016, an increase of 55%.
- 94 Incidents of Assault Causing Harm are recorded in 2017, as opposed to 85 in 2016, an increase of 11% .
- 251 Incidents of Minor Assault are recorded in 2017 as opposed to 237 in the same period last year showing a increase of 6%.

It should be noted that in any reference to statistics, those statistics are provisional, operational, liable to change and some possibly re-classified with the introduction of Central Statistics Office reports.
