- There have been 286 detections for the Sale/Supply of Drugs in 2017 as opposed to 206 for the same period last year, representing a increase of 39%
- There have been 80 arrests for Driving whilst intoxicated in 2017 in comparison to 64 for the same period last year an increase of 25%
- There has been 1 Fatal Road Traffic Accident recorded in 2017.
- 1582 Public Order Incidents are recorded in 2017 as opposed to 1303 incidents in 2016, showing a increase of 21%
- 245 Incidents of Drunkenness are recorded in 2017 as opposed to 201 in 2016, an increase of 22%
- 174 Incidents of Assault Causing Harm are recorded in 2017, as opposed to 181 in 2016, a decrease of 4%
- 469 incidents of Minor Assault are recorded in 2017 as opposed to 375 in the same period last year showing a increase of 25%

It should be noted that in any reference to statistics, those statistics are provisional, operational, liable to change and some possibly re-classified with the introduction of Central Statistics Office reports.
