Review of the Passport for Leisure scheme

At the November SPC meeting the review was discussed and the proposals agreed in relation to the requirement that the scheme be available to over 60's and those living or working in the City Council administrative area. However further discussion / consultation was requested in relation to the pricing structure in particular the "pay as you go rate" and also the impact of moving the scheme from the company currently providing the card service would have on the card holders who receive a broader range of information on services beyond those provided by Dublin City Council Sports and Recreation Services. There was also a request that a scheme be put in place to address the needs of disabled people who want to avail of services / facilities provided by Dublin City Council's Sports and Recreation Services. Following on from initial discussions it is proposed to continue the consultation process with a view to bringing a revised scheme to the March SPC.
