He also noted that there was extensive work carried out at the bottom of Chapelizod Hill Road at the junction of St Laurence's Road. This work was carried out to increase pedestrian safety. The removal of the traffic island was part of this work as it's proven to give pedestrians a false sense of security when crossing the road and encourages them to stop. This junction has been made narrower and a pedestrian crossing has been installed. It would be advised that people including the elderly and the young use the pedestrian crossing provided.</p> <p>It is illegal to park within 5m of the corner and also illegal to park across from a solid white line. Any parking along this stretch of road should be reported to Dublin Street Parking Services.</p> <p>With these factors in mind it would not be advised to make any changes in this area.</p>	0
