- There were no murders in 2018.
- There have been 11 detections for the Sale/Supply of Drugs in 2018 as opposed to 17 for the same period last year, representing a decrease of 35%.
- There have been 5 arrests for Driving whilst intoxicated in 2018 in comparison to 6 for the same period last year a decrease of 17%.
- There have been 0 Fatal Road Traffic Accidents recorded in 2018.
- 35 Public Order Incidents are recorded in 2018 as opposed to 47 in 2017, showing a decrease of 26%.
- 11 Incidents of Drunkenness are recorded in 2018 as opposed to 4 in 2017, an increase of 175%.
- 11 Incidents of Assault Causing Harm are recorded in 2018, as opposed to 6 in 2017, an increase of 83% .
- 24 Incidents of Minor Assault are recorded in 2018 as opposed to 40 in the same period last year showing a decrease of 40%.

It should be noted that in any reference to statistics, those statistics are provisional, operational, liable to change and some possibly re-classified with the introduction of Central Statistics Office reports.
