	<b>Eamon Ceannt Park</b> – renewal of existing playground.	€100,000.00
	Upgrading of existing playground in <b>Bushy Park</b> & installation of new playground in <b>Herzog Park</b> currently being installed.	
Chinese Friendship Garden	<b>Herbert Park</b> – installation funded by Yangzhou City Government with technical support from DCC.	€10,000.00
Park Depot Improvement	<b>Herbert Park &amp; Ringsend Park</b> to improve entrance to the depots for maintenance vehicles	€60,000.00
Heritage Railing Repair	<b>Palmerston Park</b> repairs due to tree roots and traffic impact	€17,000.00
Park Shelter Restoration	<b>Harold's Cross Park</b>	€20,000.00
Installation of multi use games area (MUGA)	Conversion of existing Bowling Green to floodlit MUGA as per phased implementations of the landscape masterplan for <b>Herzog Park</b>	€100,000.00
Footpath upgrading and resurfacing	Upgrade and resurface the footpaths in <b>Ranelagh Gardens Park</b> – as part of the phased implementation of the landscape plan.	€40,000.00

Footpath Resurfacing & Improvements	<b>Irishtown Nature Park / Sean Moore Park</b> (along Poplar Tree Walk), <b>Dodder Valley</b> (at 9 Bridges Arch), <b>Sandymount Promenade</b> (sea damage), <b>South Dock Street park</b> (at rear of MUGA), <b>Palmerston Park</b> .	€62,000.00
