- There have been 0 murders recorded in 2018.
- There have been 15 detections for the Sale/Supply of Drugs in 2018 as opposed to 45 for the same period last year, representing an decrease of 67%.
- There have been 13 arrests for Driving whilst intoxicated in 2018 in comparison to 17 for the same period last year an decrease of 24%.
- There have been 0 Fatal Road Traffic Accidents recorded in 2018.
- 99 Public Order Incidents are recorded in 2018 as opposed to 132 in 2017, showing a decrease of 25%.
- 27 Incidents of Drunkenness are recorded in 2018 as opposed to 15 in 2017, an increase of 80%.
- 26 Incidents of Assault Causing Harm are recorded in 2018, as opposed to 30 in 2017, a decrease of 13% .
- 66 Incidents of Minor Assault are recorded in 2018 as opposed to 78 in the same period last year showing a decrease of 15%.

It should be noted that in any reference to statistics, those statistics are provisional, operational, liable to change and some possibly re-classified with the introduction of Central Statistics Office reports.
