**Report to the Chairperson and Members of the North Central Area Committee**

**Re: Grants towards the running costs of private swimming pools for year 2018.**

An application has been received for financial assistance towards the running costs of the private swimming pool listed below, for the year 2018. The Pool Administrator has submitted accounts showing the operating costs. The pool provides swimming facilities for schools, clubs, groups and the general public in its catchment area.

Dublin City Council has supported this facility financially over the years to ensure that the swimming pool remains open for public use as the Council does not operate a swimming pool / leisure centre in this area. The grant is conditional on the swimming pool being available for public use. The grant being recommended is the same as the grant in 2017. The swimming pool would not be available to the public without the financial assistance of Dublin City Council.
