There is at present clashes with pedestrians waiting for lights not expecting cyclists to mount the footpath to access the cycle cross over. (Mobhi Road, Whitehall CDET and PizzaDog Drumcondra) Mostly cyclists carry on up the footpath and clash further with user on footpath on Mobhi Road.

At present there is a small number of cyclists going at fast speeds catching pedestrians unawares on both these cycle paths.
