- There have been 97 detections for the Sale/Supply of Drugs in 2018 as opposed to 121 for the same period last year, representing a decrease of 20%
- There have been 28 arrests for Driving whilst intoxicated in 2018 in comparison to 39 for the same period last year, an decrease of 28%
- There has been 1 Fatal Road Traffic Accident recorded in 2018.
- 1068 Public Order Incidents are recorded in 2018 as opposed to 935 incidents in 2017, showing a increase of 14%
- 110 Incidents of Drunkenness are recorded in 2018 as opposed to 120 in 2017, a decrease of 8%
- 82 Incidents of Assault Causing Harm are recorded in 2018, as opposed to 84 in 2017, a decrease of 2%
- 227 incidents of Minor Assault are recorded in 2018 as opposed to 237 in the same period last year showing a decrease of 4%
