Bóthar Bhinn Éadair, Chluain Tarbh, Baile Átha Cliath 3**

This is a new residential development on a site at 193-195 Howth Road, Clontarf, Dublin 3. The development will consist of six 3 storey 4 bedroom detached houses. The development is indicated on the attached drawing **RM 37021**.

Pierce & Associates Architects have requested the name "Wood Ville" for the development because the site is located on the lands of a large historic dwelling named "Wood Ville" (removed prior to 1930) which was accessed from the Howth Road. The Heritage Officer considers the proposed name appropriate
