#### Monthly Local Fund Statement

## Background

Attached for consideration by the elected members in this September Council Agenda is the Local Fund Statement for the period 30<sup>th</sup> June 2018 to 27<sup>th</sup> July 2018. This report is presented in a format agreed at the Finance SPC and noted by the City Council at its meeting in September 2011. The agreed format provides information on:

- Monthly receipts and payments for current period and same period last year.
- Cumulative receipts and payments for current year and last year.
- Details of main receipting areas and receipts over €1m for the current month and same period last year.
- Details of payroll payments and non pay payments over €1m in the current month and same period last year.

## Overview

Over the period 30/06/18 to 27/07/18 Dublin City Council made payments to the value of  $\in$ 156.7m. Dublin City Council receipted  $\in$ 115.5m of funds with an excess of payments over receipts of  $\in$ 41.2m moving to a net debit balance at period end of  $\in$ 64.9m. This value of  $\in$ 64.9m is the maximum value applicable, as it includes the full value of payments made whether cashed or not. As at 27/07/2018 Dublin City Council had placed  $\in$ 167m on investment. The net transfer to investment over the period was  $\in$ 51m. There were 4 weeks in each of the July periods for 2018 and 2017.

## Receipts

During the period Dublin City Council receipted €115.5m. €37.9m was received from Department of Housing, Planning and Local Government (€17.5m recoupment of Homeless Expenditure, €6.7m Public Service Pay Restoration (80%), €2.5m Social Housing claim, €3.4m Homeless Accommodation, €5m in respect of CALF payments, €1.4m in respect of North East Inner City Initiative). €5.0m was received from the other 3 Dublin local authorities (€1.6m from South Dublin, €1.2m from Dun Laoghaire, €1.7 from Fingal all for Fire Brigade contributions, €500k from Fingal for Homeless Policy contribution. €4.1m was received from Irish Water in respect of the SLA. Parking meter receipts in the period amount to €2m, €1.0m from collections and €1.0m from tags and mobile receipts (tags and mobiles for 2017 related to 2 weeks only). Commercial rates receipts in the period amount to €28.9m (ESB paid €5.7m in July 2017, paid in June 2018). €8.4m was receipted in respect of HFA Borrowings. €3.9m was received from Alcove Properties in settlement of a reverse charge VAT liability re Charlemont land swap to be paid over to Revenue Commissioners on

July/August return. Development Levy receipts during the period amounted to €2.8m, of this €859k related to a development at Cardiff Lane, €273k to a development at Royal Canal Park. An IPB Insurance Dividend of €2.2m was received in July.

## Payments

During the period Dublin City Council made payments to the value of €156.7m. A total of €4.4m was paid in contractor payments, of which €1.3m to Focus Ireland for June HAP Payments, and €3.1m to Department of Housing, Planning and Local Government in respect of Q2 Pension Related Deduction payment.

## EU/IMF Reporting

The next report under the EU/IMF reporting framework is for the 2<sup>nd</sup> Quarter 2018 (i.e. April - June). The deadline for submission of the EU/IMF reports is 24<sup>th</sup> August 2018. These reports will be included with the Financial Report for the October 2018 City Council meeting.
