Central Area Age Friendly Report – September 2018

A recent review of the City wide programme, which involved extensive consultation and engagement with key programme stakeholders – including both agency based personnel and Older Peoples Council representatives – have informed a set of recommendations together with programme wide agreement for the city wide Alliance to prioritise 3 action areas for coordinated city wide focus;

- **1. Transport and the built environment** with the goal of enhancing ease of access and movement for older people across Dublin City.
- **2. Housing + home** with the goal of supporting older people to age comfortably in the communities they belong to.
- **3.** Communications with goals to (a) raise awareness of the Dublin Age Friendly Programme (b) support an effective flow of information between the City wide Alliance and the Administrative Area programme partners and (c) ensure that older people across the City can access more timely and practical information about what is happening in their communities.

Participants then identified relevant action points to support the coordinated pursuit of the 3 agreed priority action areas and the design of an appropriate pre-Summit engagement meeting to be held on the 27th September 2018.
