- There have been 0 murders recorded in 2018.
- There have been 55 detections for the Sale/Supply of Drugs in 2018 as opposed to 92 for the same period last year, representing a decrease of 40%.
- There have been 20 arrests for Driving whilst intoxicated in 2018 in comparison to 34 for the same period last year a decrease of 41%.
- There have been 2 Fatal Road Traffic Accidents recorded in 2018.
- 220 Public Order Incidents are recorded in 2018 as opposed to 239 in 2017, showing a decrease of 8%.
- 44 Incidents of Drunkenness are recorded in 2018 as opposed to 34 in 2017, a increase of 29%.
- 59 Incidents of Assault Causing Harm are recorded in 2018, as opposed to 63 in 2017, a decrease of 6%.
- 136 Incidents of Minor Assault are recorded in 2018 as opposed to 167 in the same period last year showing a decrease of 19%.
