

Q.1 Councillor Noeleen Reilly

To ask the Manager to arrange for an intense clean-up in (details supplied) and particularly behind the railings which is full of litter and hasn't been cleared in years.

Q.2 Councillor Noeleen Reilly

To ask the Manager to examine the replacement of lights in (details supplied). Residents are complaining that the new bulbs are much darker than the old ones and it leaves areas of the estate virtually dark late at night.

Q.3 Councillor Noeleen Reilly

To ask the Manager when the Pedestrian Crossing at (details supplied) will be put in place.

Q.4 Councillor Noeleen Reilly

To ask the Manager to remove the shrubs at the side of (details supplied). Residents wish to clear this area so they can plant and make the area more attractive.

To ask the Manager for gates to stop anti-social behaviour at (details supplied). The resident has to contend with gangs sitting on her stairs. Gates have been erected in other spots of the area.

To ask the Manager for an update on (details supplied) as agreed per the Local Area Plan.

To ask the Manager if the mobile cameras can be used in (details supplied) to tackle the chronic problems of illegal dumping at these spots.

To ask the Manager what sites will DCC be applying for under the (details supplied). When and what is the expected cost per home under this scheme.

Q.9 Councillor Noeleen Reilly

To ask the Manager to arrange for the gullies to be cleared in (details supplied).

Q.10 Councillor Noeleen Reilly

To ask the Manager if the broken trees can be removed from (details supplied) and replaced with a planter which residents have agreed to look after.

Q.11 Councillor Anthony Connaghan

To ask the Manager to arrange for the footpaths at (details supplied) to be repaired/reinstated. There have been several accidents on this road due to the uneven surface.

Q.12 Councillor Anthony Connaghan

To ask the Manager to arrange for a plumber to call out to (details supplied) The tenant here has been reporting a leak for about a year which is most probably coming from pipes behind boxing in the upstairs bathroom and running down into the kitchen. To date a handyman has called out twice to replace taps but the problem still exists.

To ask the Manager to arrange for a full inspection of (details supplied), where an elderly lady lives, to attend to housing maintenance problems including

- (a) front door and windows
- (b) Faulty sockets in bedroom
- (c) faulty light switch in bedroom
- (d) leak under kitchen sink
- (e) leak in upstairs toilet

Q.14 Councillor Anthony Connaghan

To ask the Manager to arrange for the brambles on the green area to the side of (details supplied) to be pruned back.

Q.15 Councillor Anthony Connaghan

To ask the Manager to arrange for the necessary funding to be provided to re-instate the roads and footpaths on (details supplied). This was promised years ago and has not been followed through on.

To ask the Manager to provide a No Parking road marking at the entrance of the crèche on (details supplied).

To ask the Manager to provide a litter bin at the bus stop beside (details supplied).

To ask the Manager to arrange for the tree at (details supplied) to be inspected and put on list for pruning. Can the Manager arrange for the footpath to also be inspected and repaired as it is in a poor condition due to tree roots.

To ask the Manager the possibility of having traffic calming placed on (details supplied). Motor bikes are using this section of the road as a race track endangering people. Another issue is the schools and church here where children are being put in danger by those on the bikes.

To ask the Manager if there can be an increase in lighting along (details supplied) The nights are getting darker earlier and there is a public safety risk along here.

To ask the Manager If the green at (details supplied) can be cleaned up and this stop monitored as there is constant dumping and litter here. This stop is also on a main thoroughfare and bus route throughout the area.

To ask the Manager in relation to the existing housing voids and the new contractor Framework, can the Manager provide an update on progress. When was the tender for the new Framework advertised and has there been any interest from contractors. When do we expect the new Framework to become active.

To ask the Manager to confirm a timeframe for the new windows at (details supplied). They were measured 18 months ago and works have yet to be completed. Please note the medical condition of the tenant and the doctors note attached. The dampness is hampering the tenant's condition and I would request that the works be prioritised

To ask the Manager to discuss with (details supplied) the possibility of installing CCTV cameras there and to consider options of who would monitor them and how they might be financed. There have been a number of burglaries there in recent weeks and the senior citizens are being targeted

Q.59 Councillor Cathleen Carney Boud

To ask the Manager to consider the security measures that could be taken to protect vulnerable senior citizens in our complexes in (details supplied 1). If security measures are improved at (details supplied 2) the other complexes are at risk of being targeted by the same gang.

To ask the Manager to arrange for the pruning of the tree at the side of (details supplied) which is leaning over and damaging the pillar there.

To ask the Manager to arrange as a special request given the age of the tenant to cut the overgrown garden at (details supplied) as she is unable to cut it herself.

To ask the Manager to contact the owners of (details supplied) to ensure that the bin collections have been resumed and that the build-up of waste in the garden is removed immediately. Can the manager confirm if a fine can or has been imposed on the owner with regards to this issue as it has been ongoing for some time now. Please see photo attached.

To ask the Manager to confirm if there are any council tenants on the same drainage line as the resident at (details supplied). The sewerage is constantly backing up there and the resident is left with the bill to have to it cleared. If there are council tenants on this line could they now take a share of the financial burden of the works and arrange for a clearing of the drainage at the main sewerage drain in the garden of (details supplied)

Q.64 Councillor Cathleen Carney Boud

To ask the Manager to consider again the need for parking spaces at (details supplied) where large numbers of cars dropping kids off to their sports activities. There is currently no parking for anyone to use the park and residents in the area are tormented with their roads and paths being blocked most evenings and weekends for hours. I note that (details supplied 2) has a large number of parking spaces provided

there and the same should be arranged for (details supplied 1). I have previously suggested a location but this suggestion has never been followed through.

To ask the Manager why are these containers being deposited on (details supplied). Do they belong to the Council or their contractor.

Q.66 Councillor Paul McAuliffe

To ask the Manager can the remaining lanes in (details supplied) which are made of tarmac and are breaking up be resurfaced.

Q.67 Councillor Paul McAuliffe

To ask the Manager to outline if (details supplied), particularly the even numbers side, is due to receive resurfacing work.

Q.68 Councillor Andrew Montague

To ask the Manager to remove the rubble and spray the weeds in the lane at the back of Windele Road.

To ask the Manager provide dishing of the footpath where the new footpath has been laid, at the crossing from Shanvarna Road to Shanrath Road.

To ask the Manager replace the bin outside Corpus Christi school on Homefarm Road. It was removed when the footpaths were being repaired.

To ask the Manager dish the footpath between 27 and 29 Shanliss Road. One side of this junction has been dished, but not the other site. See photo.

To ask the Manager if he will give consideration to including the remainder of a location (details supplied), in the 2019 in major works programme for footpath and carriageway repair, to complete the portion of work carried out under the current 2018 programme.

To ask the Manager to provide an update on the long promised replacement equipment for a location (details supplied) and if he will commit to a decision being taken on the upgrade or replacement of this equipment being carried out as soon as possible.
