I note that a large set of reports and data files from CDM Smith re the Poolbeg commissioning have been made available as:

This is a single zip file of over 70 Mbytes. This is unreadable for members of the public.

I would request that the IT section be asked to split these materials and load them individually on the SPC agenda page where the public can retrieve individual reports as required.

There are in fact just 9 reports in this material each of which should be listed and linked in Item 3. Perhaps the "Test Data" directory which has 109 files could be loaded as one zip file.

In particular the HZI report "CCO-HZI-50060647_7.1_Test-Performance Demonstration Test 720 hours Final.pdf" is only 1.6 Mbytes.

This important document should be listed on its own as part of the agenda materials under item 3.
