CRUMLIN DISTRICT

- There have been 40 detections for the Sale/Supply of Drugs in 2018 (23 in 2017, an increase of 74%).
- There have been 35 arrests for Driving whilst intoxicated in 2018 as opposed to 30 in 2017, an increase of 17%.
- There are no Fatal Road Traffic Accidents recorded in 2018 (0 in 2017).
- 69 Public Order incidents are recorded in 2018 as opposed to 77 in 2017, a decrease of 10%.
- 37 Incidents of Assault Causing Harm are recorded in 2018 (28 in 2017).
- 57 incidents of Minor Assault are recorded in 2018 (67 in 2017, a decrease of 15%).

TERENURE SUB-DISTRICT

- There have been 11 detections for the Sale/Supply of Drugs to date in 2018 (12 in 2017).
- There have been 28 arrests for Driving whilst intoxicated in 2018 as opposed to 18 in 2017, an increase of 56%.
- There are no Fatal Road Traffic Accidents recorded in 2018 (2 in 2017, a decrease of 100%).
- 20 Public Order incidents are recorded in 2018 as opposed to 16 in 2017, an increase of 25%.
- 9 Incidents of Assault Causing Harm are recorded in 2018 (9 in 2017).
- 22 incidents of Minor Assault are recorded in 2018 (22 in 2017).
