In the event of this motion being agreed and a 5% reduction being agreed by the City Council the Labour Group will be proposing an allocation of the E4 million thus retained along the following lines

E100,000 for Arts and Community Programme.

E200,000 additional funding for Disability Grants

E200,000 for extension of Dublin Bikes Scheme

E2.5 million for direct Council build Social Housing through An Cualainn Co- Housing model.
