

Dublin City Community Enhancement Programme and Men's Shed Funding 2018

In May 2018 the Department of Rural and Community Development allocated €212,306 to the Dublin City Local Community Development Committee (LCDC) for the awarding of capital grants to local community and voluntary groups, not for profit organisations and State departments or agencies. At its meeting on 17 May 2018 the LCDC nominated a Community Enhancement Programme Sub-Committee to oversee the process.

On 08 June 2018, the LCDC Sub-Committee set the following criteria against which applications would be assessed:

- Potential to contribute to the achievement of Goal 5 of the Dublin City Local Economic and Community Plan – "Provide and protect a range of public, safe and affordable amenities, activities and facilities that are relevant and accessible to people of all ages and abilities and that contribute to the health and wellbeing of all"
- Geographical balance and desirability to fund a variety of projects
- Prioritise projects or facilities located in disadvantaged areas or working to promote social inclusion
- Demonstrated need for the project and number of people that will benefit
- Demonstrated collaboration with other organisations

Notification of the scheme was sent to the full membership of the Dublin City Public Participation Network (PPN), to Dublin City Council Community Officers and to the four Local Development Companies and the Inner City Co-op to share with groups and organisations in their area. Details were also available at www.dublincity.ie and the Programme was advertised via Twitter.

The scheme was open for applications from 18 June to 30 July 2018. In July, a further €33,334 was allocated to Dublin City to be ring-fenced for small-scale capital grants for Men's Sheds within the Dublin City administrative area. Only Men's Sheds that were affiliated with the Irish Men's Sheds Association were eligible to apply. Each eligible Men's Shed was invited directly to apply for funding under this stream of the Programme, which had a nationally-set deadline of 31 August 2018.

Following the LCDC Sub-Committee's assessment of applications on 5th September 2018, the Department announced a further €1,117,518 under the Community Enhancement Programme for Dublin City, bringing the total amount of funding available to €1,329,824. The Sub-Committee met again on Monday 1st October to carry out a full re-assessment of applications in light of the additional funding. The recommendations of the Sub-Committee were approved by the full LCDC at its meeting on Thursday 4th October and by follow-up email on Monday 8th October 2018.

Furthermore, the LCDC agreed that the surplus of funding following this assessment (€106,804.39) would be administered as follows:

- Eight applications that were unsuccessful on the basis that the proposals were not for capital projects would be given an opportunity to re-apply for a small-scale capital grant
- Following that process the remainder should be divided evenly between each of the five Dublin City Council administrative areas for City Council Community Officers to work with the relevant Partnerships / Co-op to invite a small number of local community and voluntary groups in their area to apply for capital grants
- All additional applications will be brought to the LCDC for assessment and approval
