#### Halloween Report 2018

There were two large bonfires in the Central Area, Sheriff Street at the Royal Canal bank and Railway Street at Peadar Kearney house on Halloween night.

The Cauldron of Smithfield took place on Smithfield Square with a large crowd attending and no fires were reported in Dorset Street, Hardwicke Street, Greek Street or Drumalee Estate.

A large parade took place in Eastwall with over 100 children in attendance, culminating in a haunted house and Samba band performance in Saint Mary's recreation centre.

A street party and fancy dress parade took place in Sheriff Street lower with a large attendance and participation of local children.

Mud Island held their Halloween party and the garden was open to all with a haunted house and a large attendance from locals and the wider community.

The Central Area office received co-operation from the Gardai, CIE, and Waterways Ireland with over 50 tyres removed from the Royal Canal at Guild Street Linear Park. Gardai confiscated two truckloads of tyres from youths and they were collected and disposed of from Store Street Station by Dublin City Council crews.
