Recommended	Dublin City Council's policy is to only install "children crossing" signs (W142) at the entrances to housing estates from main traffic routes, and not at locations within housing estates, as this would lead to a proliferation of same and additional expense due to maintenance, etc. However, following a site inspection it was observed that there was an increased danger to children crossing Saint Mary's Road due to vehicles turning at the Saint Mary's Road / West Road and Saint Mary's Road / Church Road junctions. Therefore, it is recommended that two children crossing signs (W142) are installed on special grounds. Stat(s): 1.Install a W 142: Children Crossing sign on the north side of Saint Mary's Road (East Wall), at a point 15 meters east of the Saint Mary's Road / West Road junction. 2.Install a W 142: Children Crossing sign on the south side of Saint Mary's Road (East Wall), at a point 10 meters west of the Saint Mary's Road / Church Road junction.
