- There have been 190 detections for the Sale/Supply of Drugs in 2018 as opposed to 284 for the same period last year, representing a decrease of 33%
- There have been 73 arrests for Driving whilst intoxicated in 2018 in comparison to 84 for the same period last year, a decrease of 13%
- There has been 1 Fatal Road Traffic Accident recorded in 2018.
- 1435 Public Order Incidents are recorded in 2018 as opposed to 1519 incidents in 2017, showing a decrease of 6%
- 211 Incidents of Drunkenness are recorded in 2018 as opposed to 240 in 2017, an increase of 12%
- 182 Incidents of Assault Causing Harm are recorded in 2018, as opposed to 178 in 2017, an increase of 2%
- 456 incidents of Minor Assault are recorded in 2018 as opposed to 473 in the same period last year showing a decrease of 4%

It should be noted that in any reference to statistics, those statistics are provisional, operational, liable to change and some possibly re-classified with the introduction of Central Statistics Office reports.
