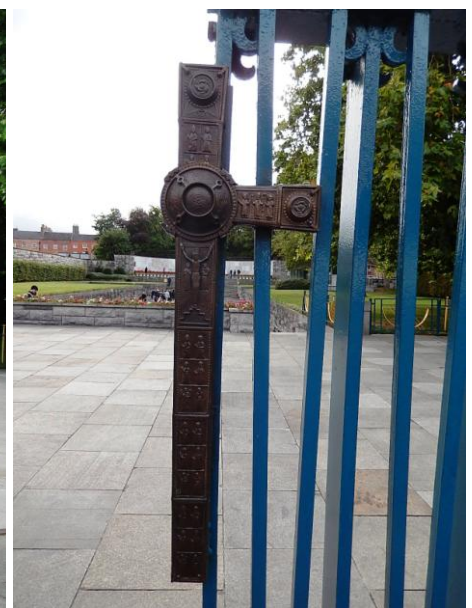
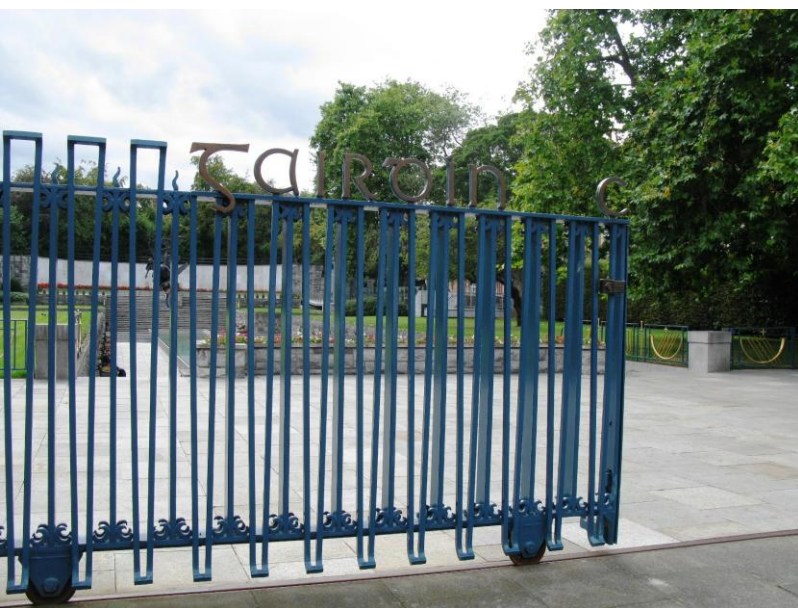

Mosaic detail to pond displaying swords, spears and shields reflecting the strong use of ancient Celtic motifs in Hanley's design.

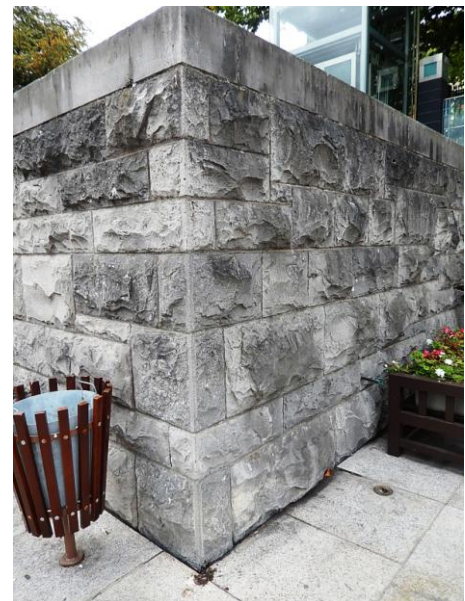
