CRUMLIN DISTRICT

- There have been 4 detections for the Sale/Supply of Drugs in 2019 (5 in 2018, an decrease of 20%).
- There have been 7 arrests for Driving whilst intoxicated in 2019 (4 in 2018, an increase of 75%).
- There are no Fatal Road Traffic Accidents recorded in 2019 (0 in 2018).
- 9 Public Order incidents are recorded in 2019 the same as in 2018.
- 6 Incidents of Assault Causing Harm are recorded in 2019 the same as in 2018.
- 13 incidents of Minor Assault are recorded in 2019 (9 in 2018, an increase of 44%).

TERENURE SUB-DISTRICT

- There have been 1 detections for the Sale/Supply of Drugs to date in 2019 (2 in 2018, a decrease of 50%).
- There have been 5 arrests for Driving whilst intoxicated in 2019 (2 in 2018, an increase of 150%).
- There are no Fatal Road Traffic Accidents recorded in 2019 the same as in 2018.
- 3 Public Order incidents are recorded in 2019, (5 in 2018, a decrease of 40%).
- 0 Incidents of Assault Causing Harm are recorded in 2019 (1 in 2018, a decrease of 100%).
- 2 incidents of Minor Assault are recorded in 2019 (4 in 2018, a decrease of 50%).
