You will be allowed to retain possession of that dog, provided you comply fully with the requirements set out below.

- Your dog is microchipped
- Your dog is neutered / spayed
- Your dog is licensed
- Vour dog is kept under effectual control
- Your dog is muzzled and kept on a lead in a public place
