Naming & Numbering Proposal for a new residential development on a site at Griffith Avenue, Dublin 9.

Griffith Wood, Griffith Avenue, Dublin 9.

This is a new residential development of 385 units on Griffith Avenue, Dublin 9. The development is indicated on the attached drawing **SM-2019-0301**.

The development will consist of 8 houses and 7 blocks of apartments containing a total of 377 apartments. The Naming & Numbering Proposal submitted by Cairn PLC and approved by the Heritage Officer is as follows:

Overall development name

Griffith Wood, Griffith Avenue, Dublin 9/ Coill Uí Ghríofa, Ascaill Uí Ghríofa, Baile Átha Cliath 9.

Justification for the chosen overall development name:

The name Griffith Wood was chosen because of the sites position on Griffith Avenue and its rich variety of tree species. These trees are a key aspect of the design of this new development and will be enhanced with open, socially functional spaces and integrated paving and soft landscaping giving the development an open parkland feel.

Justification for the chosen roadway and apartment block names:

The historical background shows that the area within which the site is located was laid out in the eighteenth century as the demesne of Marino, a substantial house. The demesne was laid out as parkland, in which were sited various features, including a gothic temple, a hermitage, a formally-laid out garden and, most significantly, a neoclassical temple, which was called the Casino.

The Casino was designed by <u>Sir William Chambers</u> for <u>James Caulfeild</u>, <u>1st Earl of Charlemont</u>. It is one of the finest 18th century neo-classical buildings in Europe.

(Note - The more conventional spelling of Caulfield will be used in the naming of the apartment blocks instead of the original name Caulfield to avoid confusion.)
