Proposal to extinguish the Public Right of Way over a laneway accessing the rear of 2-10 Clonard Road, Dublin 12.

Proposal

The South Central Area Committee, at its meeting on the 20th Feb 2019, agreed to initiate the statutory procedures to extinguish the public right of way at the above address and allow the erection of lockable gates set back from the lane entrance. The extent of the proposed extinguishment is shown on the attached **Drawing R.M 37066**.

Statutory Requirement

Representations or objections were invited by the 3rd May 2019 via a public advertisement in the Irish Independent (Fri. 22nd Mar 2019) and site notice at the location.

Objections

No formal objections were received by close of business on **3rd May 2019**.

Service Check

Service providers have been informed of this proposal and their requirements will be facilitated.

Recommendation

I recommend that this Committee approve and refer the application to extinguish the public right of way over Clonard Lane for consideration by the City Council. The extinguishment of a public right of way is a reserved function of the City Council.
