Since the Happy Out cafe became established (a welcome development), the area has become more popular, and because there are no parking restrictions after the Wooden Bridge, the bridge and concrete path down to the beach regularly become jammed with cars, with no one able to go forward or back. Further down, near the golf club, cars are parked all the way along the path; as there are no intermittent yellow boxes, there is nowhere to pull in if a car is oncoming and often an impasse is reached where no-one can go forward or back for some distance. As cars are parked all along the path there is very little room for walkers. This issue was previously only present at the height of the summer but is now a problem not only

every weekend but on many weekdays from April/May to September. Local residents have enjoyed this beautiful amenity for decades and it is almost distressing for people now, to think that they would love to go down there but it is getting impossible to negotiate the traffic.”
