If my understanding is correct and extinguishing a public right of way is still a reserved function of councillors then, I am very disappointed by the response to my CEO Question 152 / Oct 2019 which I believe is contrary to the best property interests of neighbouring residents with access to the laneway. I’m requesting that DCC addresses this matter as per DCC policy and ensures that unintentional adverse property possession does not arise in the future by ensuring that the boundaries referred to in my Q152 are reinstated.

There are no pedestrian crossings on the west and south sides of the junction making things quite dangerous for pedestrians and other road users.
