

Public Domain Updates

Waste Management Road and Street Cleaning

All main arterial roads and local shopping precincts are serviced at present . Due to social distancing and adhering to Covid 19 restrictions Waste Management are working in smaller pods (groups)

We are monitoring the day to day Litter Bin Collection and especially after weekends when this can become problematic.

Encouraging QR scanning for reporting –

There has been a huge increase in illegal dumping of household waste. The careless littering of gloves and masks has become problematic . it is putting an immediate threat on workers who have to properly dispose of these items

There has been a notable increase of the number of trolleys around the area and therefore we will be contacting the offending stores again to remove the trolleys as soon as possible .

Area and Business Groups

Public Domain continue to work with Groups to assist ,help and advise on clean ups been carried out in their estates and Villages. We advise that social distancing must be adhered to and stay at home rules followed.

Public Domain strongly advise groups who wish to carry out works on green open spaces that they must contact our Parks section to inform and clarify any works they wish to carry out.

Graffiti

Graffiti Levels have remained high since the beginning of the year and particularly spiked since covid restrictions .

With Covid restrictions the contractor was only removing offensive / political graffiti . However the contractor is working to have the remainder removed by the end of the month.

Planters

The demand for Planters is high again this year. Groups that already have planters in place have been contacted to ensure that the planters are maintained to a good standard.

28 Planters have been ordered within the North Central Area to date. Many of these have been delivered .

Public Domain have agreed a works schedule with our Supplier P.A.C.E to maintain the existing planters along certain parts of the area as to keep a good appearance for the year ahead
