To ask the Manager to investigate the possibility of installing a public waste bin outside (details supplied).

To ask the Manager to arrange for the inspection of the drainage system at (details supplied) these drains have been cleared on a number of occasions by both DCC and a private drainage company, residents believe that there could be an underlying issue that could be investigated with a camera and further investigation.
