Crime Prevention Matters and Other Information	<p>During the period 01/08/20 to 27/08/2020 there have been 9 incidents of large numbers of youths gathering in Le Fanu Park (Skate Park), Cherry Orchard lighting fires and setting off fireworks at members of the public and Gardaí. There have also been 3 such incidents in Markievicz Park.</p> <p>Large number of Attention & Complaints (27), Information & Suspicious (26) incidents reporting anti-social behaviour, youths gathering in large numbers lighting fires setting off fireworks and watching vehicles driving dangerously on Cherry Orchard Avenue before they are abandoned and set on fire.</p> <p>Two Garda vehicles were damaged on Cherry Orchard Avenue.</p> <p>Large quantity of fireworks seized from a vehicle in Cherry Orchard Industrial Estate</p>
