- There have been no Murder's recorded for 2020
- There have been 289 detections for the Sale/Supply of Drugs in 2020 as opposed to 227 for the same period in 2019, an increase of 27%
- There have been a total of 60 arrests for Driving whilst intoxicated in 2020 in comparison to 54 for the same period in 2019, an increase of 11%
- There has been 1 Fatal Road Traffic Accident recorded in 2020 in comparison to 0 for the same period in 2019, an increase of 100%.
- 1219 Public Order Incidents were recorded in 2020 as opposed to 1502 incidents in 2019, showing a decrease of 19%
- 211 Incidents of Drunkenness were recorded in 2020 as opposed to 300 in 2019, a decrease of 30%
- 98 Incidents of Assault Causing Harm were recorded in 2020, as opposed to 175 in 2019, a decrease of 44%
- 251 incidents of Minor Assault were recorded in 2020 as opposed to 384 in the same period last year showing an decrease of 35%

It should be noted that in any reference to statistics, those statistics are provisional, operational, liable to change and some possibly re-classified with the introduction of Central Statistics Office reports.
