- There have been no Murder's recorded for 2020
- There have been 314 detections for the Sale/Supply of Drugs in 2020 as opposed to 264 for the same period in 2019, an increase of 19%
- There have been a total of 69 arrests for Driving whilst intoxicated in 2020 in comparison to 64 for the same period in 2019, an increase of 8%
- There has been 1 Fatal Road Traffic Accident recorded in 2020 in comparison to 1 for the same period in 2019, indicating no change.
- 1458 Public Order Incidents were recorded in 2020 as opposed to 1702 incidents in 2019, showing a decrease of 14%
- 253 Incidents of Drunkenness were recorded in 2020 as opposed to 328 in 2019, a decrease of 23%
- 113 Incidents of Assault Causing Harm were recorded in 2020, as opposed to 193 in 2019, a decrease of 41%
- 267 incidents of Minor Assault were recorded in 2020 as opposed to 449 in the same period last year showing a decrease of 41%
